International Creative Metals (ICM) lead by Setrak Agonian successfully executed an extensive series of architectural metal work subcontracts during our Rockefeller Center Retail and Plaza renovation projects. These works included new decorative bronze railings, new Christmas tree plaque, a 100-ft. long bronze-hanging canopy (supporting artist glass), and over 100 decorative cast street bollards. ICM also carried out a large portion of the metal work in our Landmark restoration program including: modifying existing historic hand rails to meet new ADA standards, relocating and restoring the Historic Bronze "manzu" sculpture, and producing a new custom frame for same; and restoring "maiden & youth" sculptures including modifying existing historic bases to create new pedestal for sculptures; and finally fabricating new miscellaneous bronze articles including sculpture, trim, trench covers, building comers.
